I am writing regarding the availability of Physiotherapy Community Clinics covered by the Ministry of Health (OHIP) in St. Catharines. I recently called St. Catharines Physiotherapy Centre and found out that I am unable to receive treatment immediately due to the provider having a restriction on the number of episodes of care per year. They were able to place me on a waiting list, but could not tell me how long it would be before I would be called. There are other clinics in the Niagara Region, but I would have to travel to receive treatment from them which is not convenient. Many of them also have a waiting list for 8 to 12 weeks or more.

I would like to petition that the facility known as St. Catharines Physiotherapy Centre be granted more episodes of care per year to help provide for our city's aging population.
